Campaign Summary

Democratic primary runoff voters in the Harlingen and Laredo media markets need to see and hear that Jessica Cisneros would defund the police and border patrol which would **make us less safe and wreck our local economy**.

Cisneros has pledged to defund the border patrol and our immigration courts which would make our communities less safe, open the border, and take away good paying jobs from South Texas families.

Cisneros is backed by the "Defund the Police" movement which would take cops off the beat in our local communities.

Instead of voters hearing about Delia Ramirez, Democratic primary voters across the district need to read and see while on the go that Chicago Alderman Gilbert Villegas was a lobbyist whose firm worked with ComEd, and whose clients received millions in taxpayer-funded contracts since he was elected to the City Council.¹ Voters need to know that Villegas' lobbying firm worked for insurance companies, oil and gas companies, private prison contractors, as well as ComEd at the same time the company was bribing government officials.² He even personally received campaign contributions from a ComEd executive who was indicted for conspiracy to commit bribery.³ Voters need to know Villegas worked for his lobbying firm and was a Chicago Alderman at the same time. His firm's clients received tens of millions of dollars in taxpayer-funded contracts from the City of Chicago since he was elected to the City Council.⁴

If Democratic primary voters do hear about Delia Ramirez, they need to read and see while on the go that after Trump was elected, Ramirez cosponsored a new law in Illinois that guarantees women have the right to choose⁵, even if the U.S. Supreme Court challenges that right. She will be a leader in Congress fighting to make a national law that protects a woman's right to choose so no judge or politician can take women's rights away.
