

1.1 **Senator Carlson from the Committee on Elections, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 2386:** A bill for an act relating to campaign finance; providing funds for
1.3 transition expenses for secretary of state-elect, state auditor-elect, and attorney general-elect,
1.4 amending the definition of noncampaign disbursement; prohibiting making expenditures
1.5 for inaugural event expenses or transition expenses except through the candidate's principal
1.6 campaign committee or specified laws; authorizing rulemaking; amending Minnesota
1.7 Statutes 2024, section 10A.01, subdivision 26; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.8 Statutes, chapters 5; 6; 8; 10A.

1.9 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.10 Page 6, line 14, after "INAUGURAL" insert "EVENT"

1.11 Page 6, line 31, after "Inaugural" insert "event"

1.12 Page 7, line 5, delete everything after "to" and insert "conform to the requirements of
1.13 this bill regarding transition expenses."

1.14 Page 7, line 6, delete "candidates."

1.15 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on State and
1.16 Local Government. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
