

## S.F. No. 1662 - Major decision of nonelected local officials

**Sec. 1 [10A.52; Major Decision of nonelected officials]** codifies Minn. Rule 4511.1100 and amends the language of the rule by adding the language that appears in subdivision 1, paragraph (b).

Subdivision 1 [Major decision regarding the expenditure of public money] paragraph (a) provides that attempting to influence a nonelected local official is lobbying if the nonelected local official may make, recommend, or vote on a major decision regarding an expenditure or investment of public money. Paragraph (b) specifies that the mere act of applying for a grant or responding to an RFP is not lobbying. Further, purely administerial or technical communication regarding the application or RFP is not lobbying.

**Subdivision 2 [Actions that are a major decision regarding public funds]** provides a non-exhaustive list of four actions that are major decisions regarding public funds.

**Subdivision 3 [Actions that are not a major decision]** provides a non-exhaustive list of three actions that are not major decisions regarding public funds.
