

S.F. No. 350 – Nuclear Moratorium Repeal

In 1994, the Minnesota legislature placed a moratorium on new construction of nuclear power plants. The language is found in Minnesota Statutes, section 216B.243, subdivision 3b. The moratorium has not been amended since 1994.

Senate File 350 repeals the nuclear moratorium. Repealing the nuclear moratorium would allow the Public Utilities Commission to issue certificates of need for the construction of a new nuclear-powered electric generating plants.
