

Marshall Sales Tax

The Legacy Amendment increased the state's sales tax by $\frac{3}{8}$ of 1% [0.375%] and went into effect in July 2009.

The City of Marshall implemented a 0.50% local option sales tax in April 2013. From April 2013 through October 2024 settlement, the City collected \$18.4 million of gross sales & use tax, so the Legacy Amendment sales tax has collected just over \$13.8 million during that same period from sales within the City of Marshall.

Marshall was awarded a combined \$39,498 through the Arts & Cultural Heritage Fund in 2012, 2016, and 2022.

The \$13.8 million estimate does not include any collections for the first 3 years and 9 months of the Legacy Amendment sales tax.
