Walking in the footsteps as a protégé of her great-uncle acclaimed photographer, filmmaker, author, composer and humanitarian Gordon Parks, Dr. Robin P. Hickman-Winfield, CEO and Executive Producer, founded SoulTouch Productions, a television, film and video production, youth development, community partnership and engagement consulting, and legacy preservation company. SoulTouch's mission is to make meaningful media and produce powerful social impact experiences. Established in 2001, the business of SoulTouch and Robin's personal commitment, is to plant seeds of hope, and through the arts, media and authentic community engagement, present "visions of possibilities. "We're in the business of touching souls." Robin's strong spiritual faith and family legacy, has guided her decades of servant leadership, and the wisdom of her Mother Patricia, "Be humble, but know your .", has given her the resilience to uniquely navigate her professional journey. Years before establishing SoulTouch, Robin approached her Uncle about developing a documentary about his life. He asked, "Are you ready?" She confidently replied, "Yes, Uncle Gordon, you've groomed me well. I promise I'll protect your story." Executive Produced by Denzel Washington, in 2000 HBO premiered Half Past Autumn: The Life and Work of Gordon Parks. The promise was keep.

Robin spent many decades under Parks mentorship, and engaging youth and communities in the transformative power of his work. She's created numerous educational, media, arts and social impact initiatives, that have engaged intergenerational members of diverse communities. SoulTouch seeks to continue this work on a larger scale, in partnership with the Minnesota Humanities Center, in building collective of individuals and organizations to create a premiere Gordon Parks life and legacy experience, here in Minnesota where, Parks spent his years developing his, "choice of weapons"... His artistic vision of possibilities.
