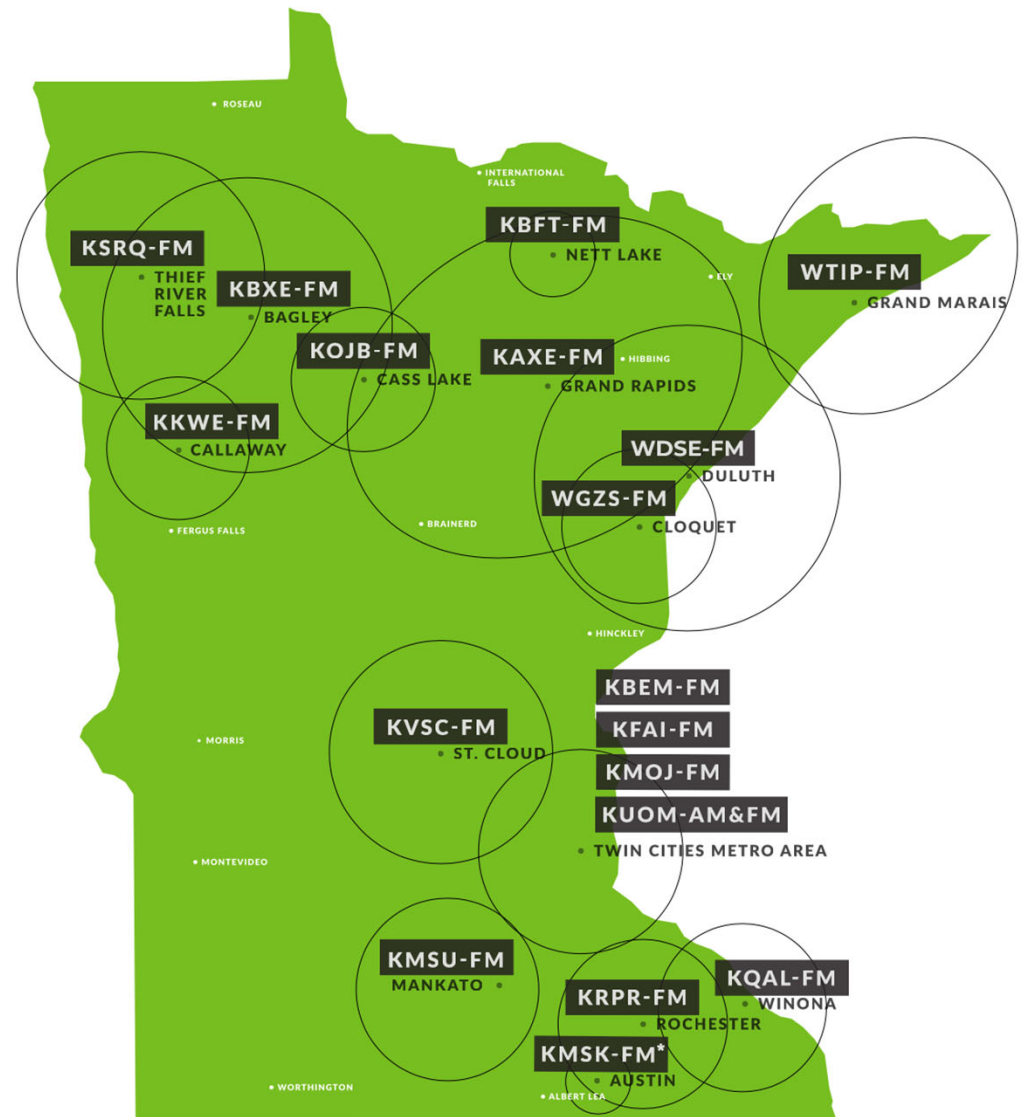


- Ampers supports 17 independent, public, hyper-local, community radio stations.
- They are licensed to a Native tribe, a community itself, or a college, school, or university.
- The stations are NOT affiliated with MPR, TPT, or MPTA.
- 13 of the 17 stations are in Greater Minnesota

- Paid more than 800 Minnesota artists
