1.7	Subd. 4b. Animal feedlot. (a) "Animal feedlot" means a lot or building or combination
1.8	of lots and buildings intended for the confined feeding, breeding, raising, or holding of
1.9	animals:
1.10	(1) that is specifically designed as a confinement area in which manure may accumulate;
1.11	<u>or</u>
1.12	(2) where the concentration of animals is such that a vegetative cover cannot be
1.13	maintained within the enclosure.
1.14	(b) Animal feedlot includes open lots used for feeding and rearing poultry, except that
1.15	a lot with 12 or fewer chickens is not an animal feedlot. Animal feedlot does not include a
1.16	pasture.
