

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2077A-4)  
1.2 to S.F. No. 2077 as follows:

1.3 Page 140, after line 2, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 5. **PRIVATE SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND.**

1.5 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, sections 92.45; 282.018, subdivision 1; or the  
1.6 public sale provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282, a county may sell by private sale  
1.7 up to ten percent of the tax-forfeited land, whether bordering public water or not, that is  
1.8 located in the county as of the effective date of this section under the remaining provisions  
1.9 of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282. The conveyance must be in a form approved by the  
1.10 attorney general. This authority is in addition to any other authority conferred on the county  
1.11 to sell tax-forfeited lands. A county that exercises its authority under this section is presumed  
1.12 to have determined that the county's land management interests would best be served if the  
1.13 land was returned to private ownership. This section expires June 30, 2027."
