

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2077A-4)  
1.2 to S.F. No. 2077 as follows:

1.3 Page 19, after line 15, insert:

1.4 "(k) \$100,000 the first year and \$200,000 the  
1.5 second year are from the general fund for a  
1.6 water availability screening tool. The  
1.7 commissioner must work with the Minnesota  
1.8 Geospatial Information Office to develop a  
1.9 water availability screening tool that uses  
1.10 existing data sets to quantify the availability  
1.11 of water across the state and be used by local  
1.12 governments, businesses, economic  
1.13 development agencies, and the state to  
1.14 determine appropriate siting for large water  
1.15 users and businesses. By January 15, 2028,  
1.16 the commissioner must submit the geospatial  
1.17 tool and methodology to the chairs and ranking  
1.18 minority members of the legislative  
1.19 committees and divisions with jurisdiction  
1.20 over environment and natural resources and  
1.21 employment and economic development. This  
1.22 is a onetime appropriation and is available  
1.23 until June 30, 2028."
