

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2781A-1)
1.2 to S.F. No. 2781 as follows:

1.3 Page 68, delete section 11 and insert:

1.4 "Sec. 11. **REPORT ON TIMELINE FOR CERTAIN AGENCY ACTIONS.**

1.5 By February 15, 2028, the Board of Water and Soil Resources must report to the chairs
1.6 and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over
1.7 environment and natural resources policy on the number of extensions noticed under
1.8 Minnesota Statutes, section 15.99, subdivision 3, paragraph (f), that are made for any decision
1.9 under Minnesota Rules, chapter 8420, between January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2027.
1.10 A local government unit must supply the board with information necessary to prepare the
1.11 report required by this section. The report must also include information on all other decisions
1.12 made under Minnesota Rules, chapter 8420, for requests that are not subject to Minnesota
1.13 Statutes, section 15.99, providing statistics on the time from submission of a complete
1.14 wetland boundary and type or wetland replacement plan application to the government unit
1.15 responsible for making the decision on the application to the approval or denial of the
1.16 application. The government unit responsible for making the decision must supply the board
1.17 with information necessary to prepare the report required by this section."

1.18 The motion prevailed. #did not prevail. So the amendment to the amendment was #not
