2.2 The commissioner of labor and industry may coordinate with the commissioners of
2.3 revenue and employment and economic development to conduct an analysis of the costs of
2.4 misclassification to illustrate how misclassification impacts misclassified workers, tax
2.5 collections, and other government programs."

2.6 Amend the title as follows:

2.7 Page 1, line 8, after the first semicolon, insert "canceling prior appropriations;"

2.8 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
