Minnesota Full-Service Community Schools Network Requests

Funding Request

MN FSCS Network is requesting \$19 million/year to sustain approximately 60 Full-Service Community Schools sites over the course of two years.

Last Cycle

\$7.5 million/year for FSCS

Upcoming Cycle

\$5 million/year, if left unchanged

Funding Need

- Without immediate action, Minnesota will see a significant reduction of FSCS sites.
- Recent inflation has disproportionally impacted low income neighborhoods.
 FSCS are designed to attract and align existing community resources and direct them to families that need them the most. FSCS is an anti-inflation strategy.
- Last year, due to limited funds, only 25
 FSCS grants were awarded out of 55
 applications. Interest in this evidence based strategy is growing and we expect
 increased applications in the future.

Proposed Legislative Changes

- Increase funding to \$19 million/year to recognize need, inflation, interest, and districts of all sizes.
- Require that grant applications be submitted by a "consortium" consisting of a school and community organization in order to recognize the centrality of community partnerships in the success of the strategy.
- Prioritize schools already utilizing FSCS strategies in support of youth and families.
- Provide flexibility for schools to build leadership councils that better reflect their site's needs and engagement levels.
- Increase funding for administrative needs (professional development, initiative support) for the MN Department of Education and the MN FSCS Network.
- Open applications to more than three schools per district.
