



S.F. No. 2007 – Full-service community schools program modifications (as proposed to be amended by the A-1 amendment)

S.F. No. 2007 modifies provisions governing full-service community schools and appropriates money for grants to plan or expand the full-service community school program.

Section 1. Full-service community schools.

Subdivision. 1. Definitions. Modifies the definition of “community organization” to specifically include community centers, universities, nonprofit organizations, or other community-based organizations that provide service to a specific geographic area. Clarifies the definition of “community school consortium.” Modifies the required composition of the community-wide full-service community school leadership team. Clarifies the definition of “school site.”

Subd. 2. Full-service community school program. Directs the commissioner to not prioritize school sites for full-service community school funding based on previous funding sources. Directs the commissioner to prioritize sites based on the site’s ability to execute the full-service community school model and the school review process among other criteria. Makes other technical changes.

Subd. 2a. School leadership team. Clarifies the composition of the school leadership team. Makes other technical changes.

Makes other technical changes to restructure the subdivisions within the section.

Sec. 2. Appropriations. Appropriates money to the Department of Education for grants to plan or expand full-service community schools. Authorizes the commissioner to retain administrative costs. Provides that up to two percent of the appropriation may be used for a grant for professional network development activities.
