BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [121A.241] CARDIAC EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN.

Subdivision 1. Cardiac emergency response plan. (a) For purposes of this section, a "cardiac emergency response plan" is a written document that establishes specific steps to reduce death from cardiac arrest. A cardiac emergency response plan must integrate evidence-based core elements, such as those recommended by the American Heart Association in accordance with a published, peer-reviewed journal article or similar document.

- (b) Beginning in the 2026-2027 school year, a school district or charter school must develop a cardiac emergency response plan that addresses the appropriate use of school personnel to respond to incidents involving an individual experiencing sudden cardiac arrest or a similar life-threatening emergency while on school grounds or at a school-sponsored activity or event. A district or charter school must consult with athletic trainers when developing the plan. A principal or other person having administrative control over the school site must ensure that the plan is:
- (1) available to the school community on the school website and in paper form at various locations at the school site;
- 1.22 (2) distributed to all coaches and other athletic staff members at each school site, all persons responsible for executing the plan in the event of a cardiac emergency, all health
