

S.F. No. 1404 – Modifying American Indian mascot provisions (1st Engrossment)

Section 1. Prohibition on American Indian mascots. Requires that a school district required to report to the legislature regarding a prohibited American Indian mascot also report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the education finance committees. Effective for reports submitted after June 30, 2025.

Sec. 2. Exemption. Modifies the process for a public school to seek an exemption to the prohibition on American Indian mascots. Removes the requirement that a school obtain consent from all 11 federally recognized Tribal Nations in Minnesota and the Tribal Nations Education Committee. Requires instead that a public school seek consent from the Tribal Nation located nearest to the school. Effective immediately.

Sec. 3. Appropriation; mascot replacement assistance. Appropriates money in fiscal year 2026 only for reimbursement to public schools for certain costs of replacing a prohibited mascot. Imposes certain administrative duties on the commissioner of education.
