- (d) A district renewing an expiring referendum under this subdivision must submit a copy of the adopted resolution to the commissioner and to the county auditor no later than September 1 August 15 of the ealendar year in which the written resolution is adopted fiscal year prior to the fiscal year in which the referendum expires.
- 2.8 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective retroactively from June 16, 2024, and applies to school board resolutions adopted on or after that date.
