

## S.F. No. 2486 – Modifying eligible uses of school library aid

**S.F. No. 2486** modifies the eligible uses of school library aid. The bill provides that (1) electronic, computer, and audiovisual equipment, and (2) information technology infrastructure and digital tools are not eligible uses of school library aid beginning in fiscal year 2026.

## Additional background information

School library aid is paid to school districts and charter schools. Under current law, school library aid must be reserved and used for directly funding the costs within a library attributable to: (1) the salaries and benefits of a school library media specialist; (2) electronic, computer, and audiovisual equipment; (3) information technology infrastructure and digital tools; (4) electronic and material resources; or (5) furniture, equipment, or supplies.
