Dear Chair Kunesh, Senator Rarick, and Members of the Senate Education Finance Committee,

I am writing you today as Executive Director of STARBASE Minnesota, Inc. to ask you to oppose SF2255 Senate Delete-All Amendment which would eliminate all funding for STARBASE. This change would have an immediate negative impact on at least 438 schools across Minnesota, by further limiting their access to high quality STEM education resources. The proposed change to delete STARBASE funding, opposes the Governor's recommended budget that includes an appropriation of \$500,000 per year in FY26-27 for STARBASE.

STARBASE provides schools throughout the State of Minnesota with free STEM education programs and resources, with proven success among students and their teachers. At a time when schools in our state are asked to do more with less, STARBASE is there, creating that spark of excitement for STEM in students and relieving the pressure on schools and educators by providing premiere STEM education programming in the form of 5-day, onsite programs or STEM kits and curriculum to schools across the state.

Minnesota is home to a strong STEM industry, contributing to the economic vitality of our state. That same STEM industry depends on a future STEM workforce and STARBASE is helping to prepare that workforce. All STARBASE lessons and activities feature a direct connection to a MN STEM career, helping students to envision themselves in the future STEM workforce.

Please accept the testimony of Ryan Gibbs, Principal, Oak View Elementary School, Osseo, Minnesota, who can share the importance of STARBASE Minnesota programs on the schools we serve.
