



S.F. No. 787 – Modifying open meeting law to allow unlimited remote participation

Section 1 amends the open meeting law to allow members of a public body to participate remotely in a meeting governed by the open meeting laws from a location that is not open and accessible to the public. Under current law, a member may only participate from a nonpublic location three times a year, and only if the member is serving in the military or has personal or family medical reasons for not being in a public place.

Section 2 amends notice requirements to conform to the changes in section 1.
