



S.F. No. 1246 – Modifying unclassified service and appointment provisions for St. Louis County

Section 1 reduces the number of Saint Louis County deputy administrators from two to one.

Section 2 repeals two sections of law:

- **Section 383C.07.** Under this section, a lay person appointed by the Saint Louis County Board to a board or commission has a three-year term.
- **Section 383C.74, subdivisions 1 to 4.** These provisions permit the Saint Louis County Board to make a yearly appropriation of up to \$2,500 to a historical society and provide for how the appropriation would be handled and spent.
