HF1837/SF2417 Policy and Technical

Clarifying and streamlining statutes

- Technical updates to conform the State's Assistive Technology Act with federal changes.
- Modify General Services Rate Report due date to better align with rate-setting schedule.
- Consolidate two similar reports on the State Fleet into one annual report.
- Clarify capital project notifications to the legislature before proceeding.
- Repeal Admin's responsibility for a model lighting ordinance for local governments.
- Exempt the Office of Ombuds for Long Term Care from state markings on fleet vehicles.



SF2578 Safeguarding State Grants

Strengthening the framework for grant makers across the state agency enterprise

- Expand suspension and debarment authority to include potential grantees who have been convicted of serious crimes.
- Streamline grant denial appeal timeline.
- Require that grantee administrative costs are "reasonable and necessary".
- Clarify the process for capital grants.



HF2232/SF2501 Strengthening State Contracting

Bolstering state contracting by clarifying unenforceable contract terms and strengthening subcontracting requirements

- Clarify process for unenforceable contract terms that conflict with other statutes.
- Strengthen subcontracting requirements by expanding the application to all prime contractors.
- Eliminate the underutilized Data Analytics Master Program
