Overview

Current Minnesota law authorizes cities and counties to conduct a background check that includes records within the state. This bill authorizes cities and counties to conduct a background check that includes the national database for applications for a license to operate an adult entertainment establishment or license to provide massage services.

Summary

Section 1 defines the term “applicant for licensure” to refer to applications to operate an adult entertainment establishment or business providing massage services.

Section 2 authorizes counties and cities to investigate the background of applicants for certain licenses. Specifically authorizes a check of national criminal records. Describes the process for a background check.
