Bill Description

This bill seeks to create a Common Interest Community Ombudsperson in the Department of Commerce. The Ombudsperson would be tasked with advocating on behalf of unit owners and facilitate resolution of disputes between unit owners and associations. The Ombudsperson would also be responsible for educating unit owners about their rights under the law.

Assumptions

The bill prohibits the Ombudsperson from rendering a legal opinion, but is tasked with resolving the dispute. Commerce does not have anyone employed in this capacity and would require a new hire who has experience in this area. In supporting the work of the Ombudsperson, the legal department would need to support the extensive legal structure behind the duties of the Ombudsperson. This would be a new process for Commerce and the legal implications need to be considered as the program rolls out. Due to the nature of the work of the Ombudsperson, there will be significant ongoing legal support needs. Commerce does get a notable amount of complaints in this area that we have to refer to other places. Based on this, Commerce assumes there would be numerous people requesting the help of the Ombudsperson.
