



S.F. No. 2631 – Modifying requirements for publishing notice in a qualified newspaper

This bill amends the law regulating qualified newspapers. In most circumstances where public notice is required by law or court order, the notice must be published in a qualified newspaper that meets certain requirements of law. This bill modifies how notices must be published if a qualified newspaper ceases to be published before a notice is published, or during the time the notice was required to be published.

Section 1 (331A.10, subdivision 2) makes drafting changes to existing law and adds a new paragraph (b). Paragraph (b) provides that, when a local qualified newspaper ceases publication, the political subdivision must post notices on its website and on the Minnesota Newspaper Association's statewide public notice website, until another qualified newspaper can be identified.
