

S.F. No. 1091 - Traffic calming grants to cities establishment

S.F. 1091 appropriates \$10,000,000 in fiscal years 2026 and 2027 from the general fund for grants to cities of the first class (Minneapolis, St. Paul, Rochester, Duluth) for a variety of eligible traffic calming infrastructure improvements.

Grant aid must be distributed as follows:

- 50 percent proportionally based on each city's share of population compared to the other cities of the first class; and
- 50 percent proportionally based on each city's share of money needs as determined by the municipal state aid formula.
