



S.F. No. 294 – Road skills examination availability; no-show fee increase authorized

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S.F. 294 modifies two provisions relating to the scheduling of a road skills test appointment (“appointments”) for a driver’s license, effective August 1, 2025.

Section 1 requires the commissioner to stagger the release of road skills exam appointments on the department’s website, with 50 percent of appointments available to book three months in advance of the projected appointment, 75 percent of appointments available two months in advance, and all potential appointments available to book within a month of the projected date.

Section 2 increases the fee from \$20 to \$50 that must be paid by an individual who fails to appear or cancels less than 24 hours before a scheduled appointment. **Section 2** requires a fee of \$20 be paid by an individual who cancels a scheduled appointment between 24 and 72 hours before the appointment time.
