1.12 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 299A.705, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.13 to read:

1.14 Subd. 5. **Deputy registrar fee-sharing account.** (a) The deputy registrar fee-sharing
1.15 account is created in the special revenue fund, consisting of fees described in section 168.33,
1.16 subdivision 7, and any other money donated, allotted, transferred, or otherwise provided to
1.17 the account.

1.18 (b) Money in the account is annually appropriated to the commissioner of public safety
1.19 to distribute to deputy registrars. At least quarterly, the commissioner must distribute the
1.20 money in the account to each deputy registrar that was in operation during that quarter based
1.21 proportionally on the total number of transactions completed by each deputy registrar.

1.22 (c) For purposes of this subdivision, "deputy registrar" includes a deputy registrar who
1.23 is a full-service provider, as defined in section 168.002, subdivision 12a.

1.24 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective October 1, 2025, and the first quarterly
1.25 distribution shall be made on or before January 15, 2026.

1.26 Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 299A.705, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.27 to read:

1.28 Subd. 6. **Driver's license agent fee-sharing account.** (a) The driver's license agent
1.29 fee-sharing account is created in the special revenue fund, consisting of fees described in
1.30 section 171.06, subdivision 2, and any other money donated, allotted, transferred, or otherwise
1.31 provided to the account.

2.1 (b) Money in the account is annually appropriated to the commissioner of public safety
2.2 to distribute to driver's license agents. At least quarterly, the commissioner must distribute
2.3 the money in the account to each driver's license agent that was in operation during that
2.4 quarter based proportionally on the total number of transactions completed by each driver's
2.5 license agent.

2.6 (c) For purposes of this subdivision, "driver's license agent" includes a driver's license
2.7 agent who is a full-service provider, as defined in section 168.002, subdivision 12a.

2.8 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective October 1, 2025, and the first quarterly
2.9 distribution shall be made on or before January 15, 2026."
