BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. ANOKA COUNTY AND CITY OF HAM LAKE; MARKED TRUNK
- 1.7

HIGHWAY 65.
- 1.8

Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$16,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
- 1.9

account in the trunk highway fund to the commissioner of transportation for preliminary
- 1.10

engineering, environmental documentation, final design, right-of-way acquisition, and
- 1.11

construction of intersection improvements along marked Trunk Highway 65 at Anoka
- 1.12

County State-Aid Highway 116, also known as Bunker Lake Boulevard Northeast, and
- 1.13

associated frontage roads and backage roads within the trunk highway system. This
- 1.14

appropriation does not require a nonstate contribution.
- 1.15

Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.16

proceeds account in the trunk highway fund, the commissioner of management and budget
- 1.17

shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$16,500,000 in the manner, upon
- 1.18

the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 167.50 to 167.52,
- 1.19

and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XIV, section 11, at the times and in the amounts
- 1.20

requested by the commissioner of transportation. The proceeds of the bonds, except accrued
- 1.21

interest and any premium received from the sale of the bonds, must be deposited in the bond
- 1.22

proceeds account in the trunk highway fund.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
