S.F. 219: Senator Abeler: Electric-assisted bicycle rebate program modification.

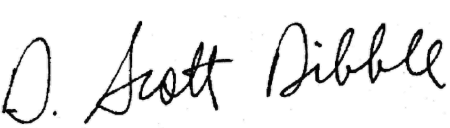
Senator Jim Abeler presented S.F. 219 - Electric-assisted bicycle rebate program modification
