Senator John R. Jasinski moved the A7 amendment. Via voice vote, the motion prevailed and the amendment was adopted.

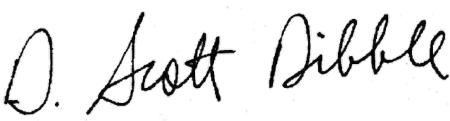
Testimony was heard from the following individuals:
