

S.F. No. 2161 – Modification of photograph requirement for certain individuals with medical devices (as amended by A-1 delete-everything)

S.F. 2161 amends the requirements that address certain coverings of the applicant's head in the photograph used for a driver's license or identification. **Section 1** allows an applicant who, because of an injury or illness that requires continuous coverage of their head or scalp, to not remove the medically required covering. The covering must not completely obscure the applicant's face in the photograph.
