Section 3 Amends 473.386, subd. 10	Metro Mobility expenditures for the prior two fiscal years are submitted in the Metro Mobility forecast (473.386, Subd. 10), submitted annually to the legislature after the February and November forecasts. Metro Mobility expenditures for the prior four fiscal years are submitted in the Transportation Financial Review (473.13, Subd. 6a), submitted annually on January 15.	Metro Mobility expenditures for the prior four fiscal years would be submitted in the Transportation Financial Review (473.13, Subd. 6a), submitted annually on January 15.
Section 4 Amends 473.412, subd 3.	The Metro Transit Cleaning and Repair Standards report (473.412, Subd. 3) is submitted October 1 annually.	The Metro Transit Cleaning and Repair Standards report (473.412, Subd. 3) would be submitted February 15 annually. This aligns with the due date for the Transit Safety and Rider Experience report (473.4077) and would provide more up to date information for the legislature to consider during the legislative session.
	The Cleaning and Repair standards report (473.412, Subd. 3) and Transit Safety and Rider Experience report (473.4077) both include recommendations regarding the transit rider code of conduct and the Transit Rider Investment Program (TRIP).	The Transit Safety and Rider Experience report (473.4077) continues to include recommendations regarding the transit rider code of conduct and the Transit Rider Investment Program (TRIP).
