



S.F. No. 3101 – Reintegration driver’s license requirements modification

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S.F. 3101 modifies two provisions related to a reintegration driver’s license.

Section 1 provides that a reintegration driver’s license expires 24 months from the date of issuance. Effective the day following final enactment for licenses issued on or after that date.

Section 2 establishes a 90-day extension period for when a reintegration driver’s license is considered expired for purposes of a person applying for and receiving their driver’s license. Effective the day following final enactment.
