



S.F. No. 684 – Clarifying notice to revisor of statutes of federal approval of legislative enactments

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Section 1 (adds Minnesota Statutes § 256.01, subdivision 44) requires the commissioner of human services to notify the revisor of statutes which enacted provisions (whether it is an effective date, statutory text, or an uncodified section of session law) contain an effective date contingent upon federal approval and when federal approval is obtained for any such provision. Requires the commissioner to provide the following reports to the revisor of statutes, the director of the House Research Department, and the director of Senate Counsel, Research, and Fiscal Analysis: (1) a report by July 1 of each year that contains a complete list of all provisions enacted since the preceding July 1 with an effective date contingent on federal approval; and (2) a report by September 1 of each year that contains a list of all statutory provisions previously enacted with an effective date contingent on federal approval and which of those provisions received federal approval since the preceding September 1.
