

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 91 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 142B.41, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.4 to read:

1.5 Subd. 14. **Staff distribution.** A child care aide in a licensed child care center may be
1.6 substituted for a teacher during morning arrival and afternoon departure times if the total
1.7 arrival and departure time does not exceed 25 percent of the center's daily hours of operation.
1.8 For a child care aide to be substituted for a teacher under this subdivision, the child care
1.9 aide must:

1.10 (1) be 18 years of age or older;

1.11 (2) have been employed by the child care center for a minimum of 30 days; and

1.12 (3) have completed the training required under section 142B.65, including orientation
1.13 training and the training required within the first 90 days of employment.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2025.

1.15 Sec. 2. **DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER OF CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND**
1.16 **FAMILIES; AMENDING STAFF DISTRIBUTION RULES FOR CHILD CARE**
1.17 **CENTERS.**

1.18 (a) The commissioner of children, youth, and families must amend Minnesota Rules,
1.19 part 9503.0040, subpart 2, item B, to conform with Minnesota Statutes, section 142B.41,
1.20 subdivision 14.

1.21 (b) Notwithstanding any other requirements for good cause-exempt rulemaking, the
1.22 commissioner may use the procedure under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subdivision
1.23 1, clause (3), for changes to Minnesota Rules pursuant to this section. Minnesota Statutes,
1.24 section 14.386, does not apply to rules amended pursuant to this section except as provided
1.25 under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388. The commissioner must submit a proposed rule
1.26 pursuant to this section to the Office of Administrative Hearings pursuant to Minnesota
1.27 Statutes, section 14.388, subdivision 1, no later than June 1, 2025."
