



S.F. No. 91 – Modifying child care center licensing (as proposed to be amended by the A-2 amendment)

Section 1 (adds Minnesota Statutes § 142B.41, subdivision 14) allows a child care aide in a licensed child care center to be substituted for a teacher during morning arrival and departure times as long as the aide meets certain requirements, and the total arrival and departure time does not exceed 25 percent of the center's daily hours of operation.

Section 2 (DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER) requires the commissioner of children, youth, and families to amend Minnesota Rules, part 9503.0040, subpart 2, item B, to conform with the language added in section 1.
