



## **S.F. No. 1173 – Allowing persons on probation or parole access to certain mental health, chemical health, or detoxification services**

**Section 1 (amends Minn. Stat. § 245.50, subdivision 3; Exceptions)** allows a person on probation or parole to receive mental health, chemical health, or detoxification services in bordering states.

**Section 2 (adds Minn. Stat. § 245.50, subdivision 6; Contract notice)** requires a Minnesota mental health, chemical health, or detoxification facility that enters into a contract with a bordering state for mental health, chemical health, or detoxification services to provide the commissioner of human services with a copy of the contract within 30 days, along with any amendments.
