



S.F. No. 164 – Requiring public postsecondary institutions to maintain a supply of opiate antagonists

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Section 1 requires the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system, and requests the University of Minnesota system, to maintain two doses of opiate antagonists in each campus residential building. Opiate antagonists are drugs that can reverse the effects of an opioid overdose.

The Department of Health is required to provide materials to the systems to support the development of opiate antagonist emergency plans.

Section 2 allows a licensed physician or advance practice nurse to authorize a nurse or other person employed by, or under contract with, a postsecondary institution to administer an opiate antagonist.
