1.2       **was referred**

1.3       **S.F. No. 1024:** A bill for an act relating to health insurance; establishing a premium  
1.4       subsidy program administered by MNsure; providing a sunset for the Minnesota premium  
1.5       security plan; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 62E.23,  
1.6       subdivision 1; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62V; repealing  
1.7       Minnesota Statutes 2024, sections 62E.21; 62E.22; 62E.23; 62E.24; 62E.25.

1.8       Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.9       Page 2, line 16, delete "receiving" and insert "eligible for"

1.10       Page 2, line 18, delete "section 256B.055 or 256L.04" and insert "chapters 256B and  
1.11       256L"

1.12       Page 3, line 21, delete everything after the period

1.13       Page 3, delete line 22

1.14       Page 3, line 23, delete everything before "The"

1.15       Page 3, after line 32, insert:

1.16       "(e) The board may withhold payments, charge back payments, and otherwise utilize  
1.17       all authority granted to the board under state law to recover from health carriers premium  
1.18       subsidies provided but that do not comply with the applicable legal requirements of this  
1.19       section."

1.20       Page 4, delete subdivision 4

1.21       Renumber the subdivisions in sequence

1.22       Page 4, line 10, delete everything after the comma

1.23       Page 4, delete lines 11 to 13

1.24       Page 4, line 14, delete "(2)"

1.25       Page 4, line 15, delete "sections 256B.055 and 256L.04" and insert "chapters 256B and  
1.26       256L"

1.27       Page 4, after line 29, insert:

1.28       "**Sec. 6. REVISOR INSTRUCTION.**

1.29       The revisor of statutes must remove or amend, as applicable, all references and provisions  
1.30       relating to the premium security account and the Minnesota premium security plan in the  
1.31       Minnesota Statutes to reflect the expiration of the Minnesota premium security plan as  
1.32       intended in this act."
