1.8BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.9Section 1. Laws 2023, chapter 70, article 20, section 2, subdivision 30, is amended to

2.8 Sec. 2. **DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES; CLAY**  
2.9 **COUNTY PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY PER DIEM**  
2.10 **RATE.**

2.11 Notwithstanding any statutory requirements to the contrary under Minnesota Statutes,  
2.12 section 256B.0941, subdivision 3, when establishing the provider-specific per diem rate  
2.13 under Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.0941, subdivision 3, for the Clay County psychiatric  
2.14 residential treatment facility, the commissioner of human services must establish the rate  
2.15 in an amount equal to or greater than \$1,800 per diem.

2.16 Sec. 3. **APPROPRIATION; CLAY COUNTY PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL**  
2.17 **TREATMENT FACILITY.**

2.18 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner  
2.19 of human services for a grant to Clay County for costs related to the purchase of equipment  
2.20 and final redesign and remodeling for the conversion of the West Central Regional Juvenile  
2.21 Center nonsecure unit into an 18-bed psychiatric residential treatment facility for persons  
2.22 younger than 21 years of age, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.0941. This is  
2.23 a onetime appropriation.

2.24 Sec. 4. **APPROPRIATIONS; PSYCHIATRIC RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT**  
2.25 **START-UP AND CAPACITY-BUILDING GRANTS.**

2.26 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2026 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2027 are appropriated from  
2.27 the general fund to the commissioner of human services for psychiatric residential treatment  
2.28 facility start-up and capacity-building grants under Minnesota Statutes, section 256B.0941,  
2.29 subdivision 5. Of these amounts, \$200,000 in fiscal year 2026 is for a grant award to Clay  
2.30 County for eligible grant activities related to a new 18-bed psychiatric residential treatment  
2.31 facility in the county. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2029.
