Section 1 (Direction to commissioner; Report on out-of-school and youth programming) requires the commissioner of children, youth, and families to evaluate statewide availability of out-of-school and youth programming available to youth 21 years of age or younger and provides what the evaluation must include. Requires the commissioner to utilize a community engagement process throughout the evaluation and to provide a report to the legislature that includes the commissioner's findings and finance and policy recommendations.

Section 2 (Appropriation) contains a blank, onetime appropriation from the general fund to the commissioner of children, youth, and families for the out-of-school and youth programming evaluation and report.
