S.F. No. 2210 / H.F. No. 129 modifies reporting requirements for the director of child sex trafficking prevention related to the statewide program for safe harbor for sexually exploited youth. Current law requires the director to submit an updated evaluation of the program every two years to the commissioner of health. This bill requires the director to submit an updated evaluation each odd-numbered year, and adds that the evaluation must be provided to legislature in addition to the commissioner.
