



## **H.F. No. 1346 – Maltreatment of minors mandatory reporter training modification**

**Section 1 (amends Minn. Stat. § 260E.065; Training for reporters)** specifies that for training offered by local welfare agencies to individuals mandated to report child maltreatment, at least half of the training time must be spent on how to identify signs of suspected child maltreatment or abuse. Requires that this training must cover the definition of each maltreatment type in section 260E.03, subdivision 12. Requires the commissioner of children, youth, and families to create trainings with input from professionals with specialized knowledge related to child maltreatment.
