



## **S.F. No. 2819 – Green Burial Requirements (2<sup>nd</sup> Engrossment)**

**SF 2819** defines “green burials” and creates a certain requirements for public and private cemeteries who offer green burials and who allow for the scattering of hydrolyzed remains or cremated remains.

**Section 1** (amends section 149A.02) defines “green burials.”

**Section 2 [306.991; Green Burials in Public Cemeteries]** defines several terms related to green burials. Establishes certain requirements related to green burial plots, burial depth, and density.

**Section 3 [306.992; Scattering of Hydrolyzed or Cremated Remains]** requires a public cemetery that allows the scattering of hydrolyzed or cremated remains to designate a specific location for the scattering of the remains.

**Section 4 [307.14; Green Burials in Private Cemeteries]** defines several terms related to green burials. Establishes certain requirements related to green burial plots, burial depth, and density.

**Section 5 [307.15; Scattering of Hydrolyzed or Cremated Remains]** requires a private cemetery that allows the scattering of hydrolyzed or cremated remains to designate a specific location for the scattering of the remains.
