

Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2669A-6) to S.F. No. 2669 as follows:

Page 565, after line 10, insert:

"Sec. 19. DIRECTION TO THE COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES; PROGRAM FLEXIBILITY.

Without needing prior legislative approval, the commissioner of human services may temporarily restructure, consolidate, or pause programs administered by the commissioner during periods of financial hardship to accomplish the mission of the Department of Human Services in creative ways. The commissioner must notify the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over human services at least five business days prior to any programmatic changes taking effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.

Sec. 20. DIRECTION TO THE COMMISSIONER OF CHILDREN, YOUTH, AND FAMILIES; PROGRAM FLEXIBILITY.

Without needing prior legislative approval, the commissioner of children, youth, and families may temporarily restructure, consolidate, or pause programs administered by the commissioner during periods of financial hardship to accomplish the mission of the Department of Children, Youth, and Families in creative ways. The commissioner must notify the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over human services at least five business days prior to any programmatic changes taking effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.

Sec. 21. DIRECTION TO THE COMMISSIONER OF HEALTH; PROGRAM FLEXIBILITY.

Without needing prior legislative approval, the commissioner of health may temporarily restructure, consolidate, or pause programs administered by the commissioner during periods of financial hardship to accomplish the mission of the Department of Health in creative ways. The commissioner must notify the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over human services at least five business days prior to any programmatic changes taking effect.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment."
