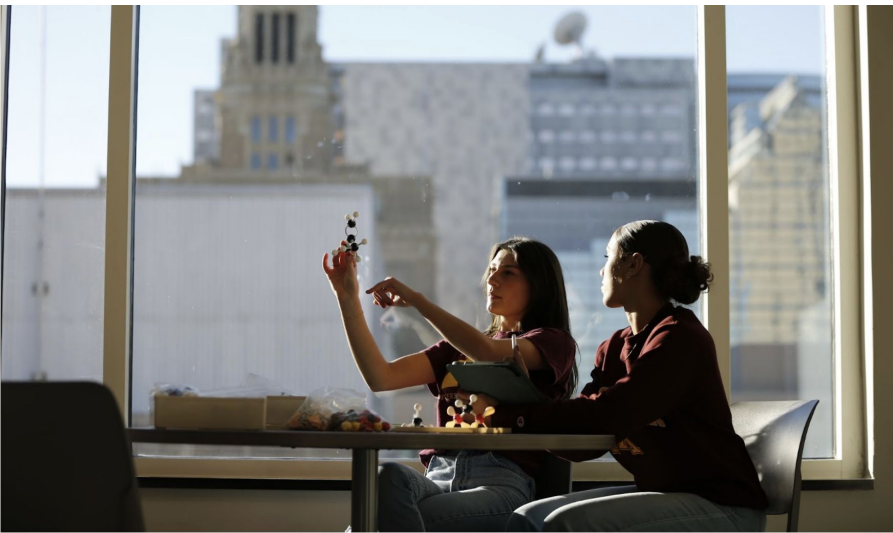

- Students learn from outstanding faculty and teachers in dynamic physical and virtual spaces

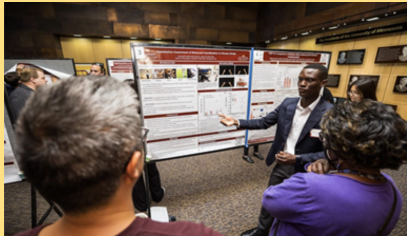
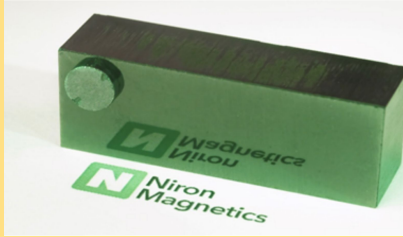


Research and Innovation

We train Minnesota's health professional workforce.

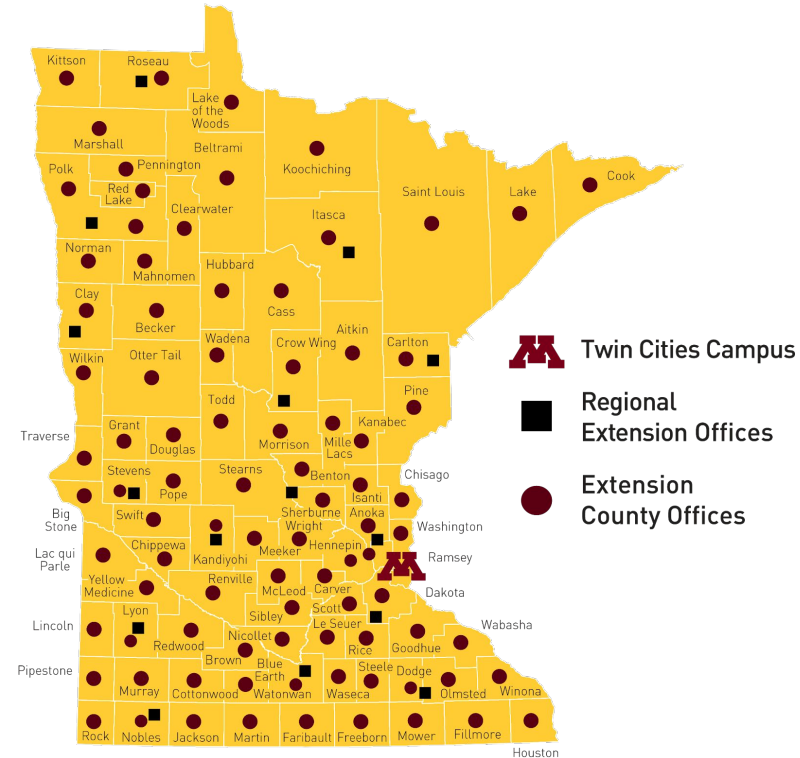
