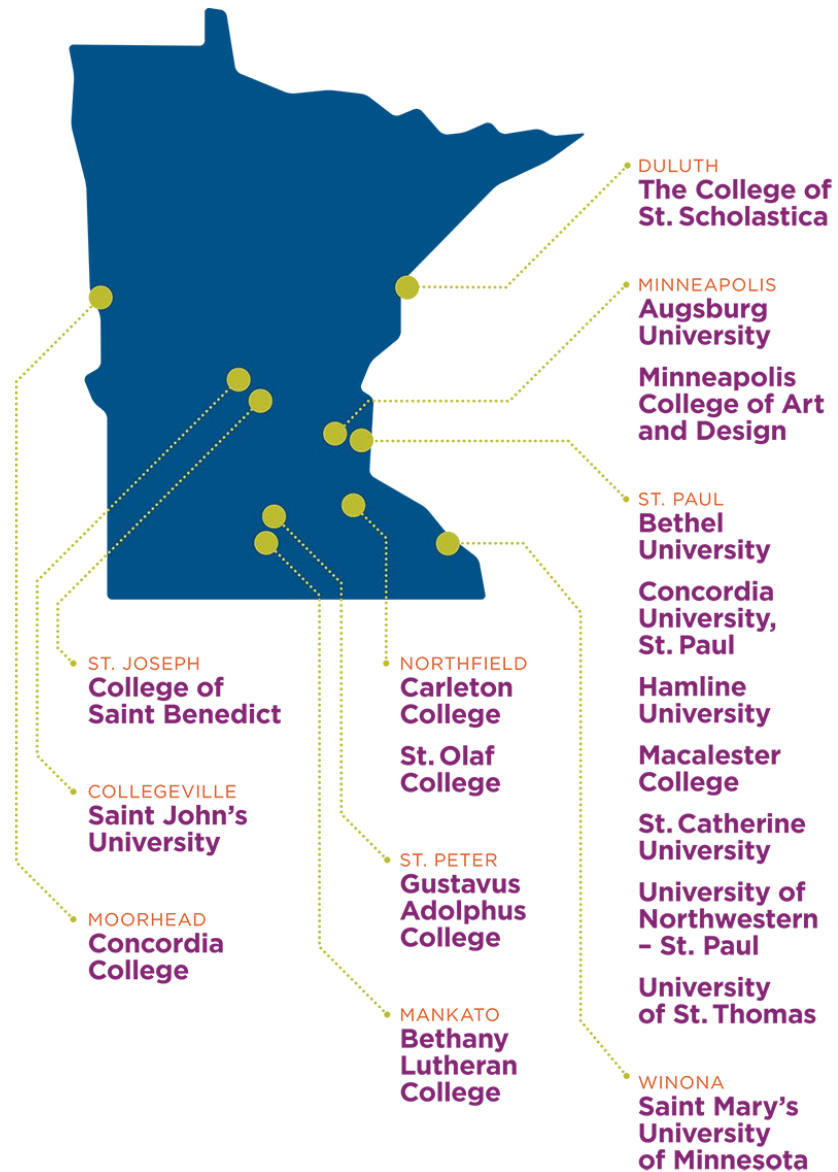

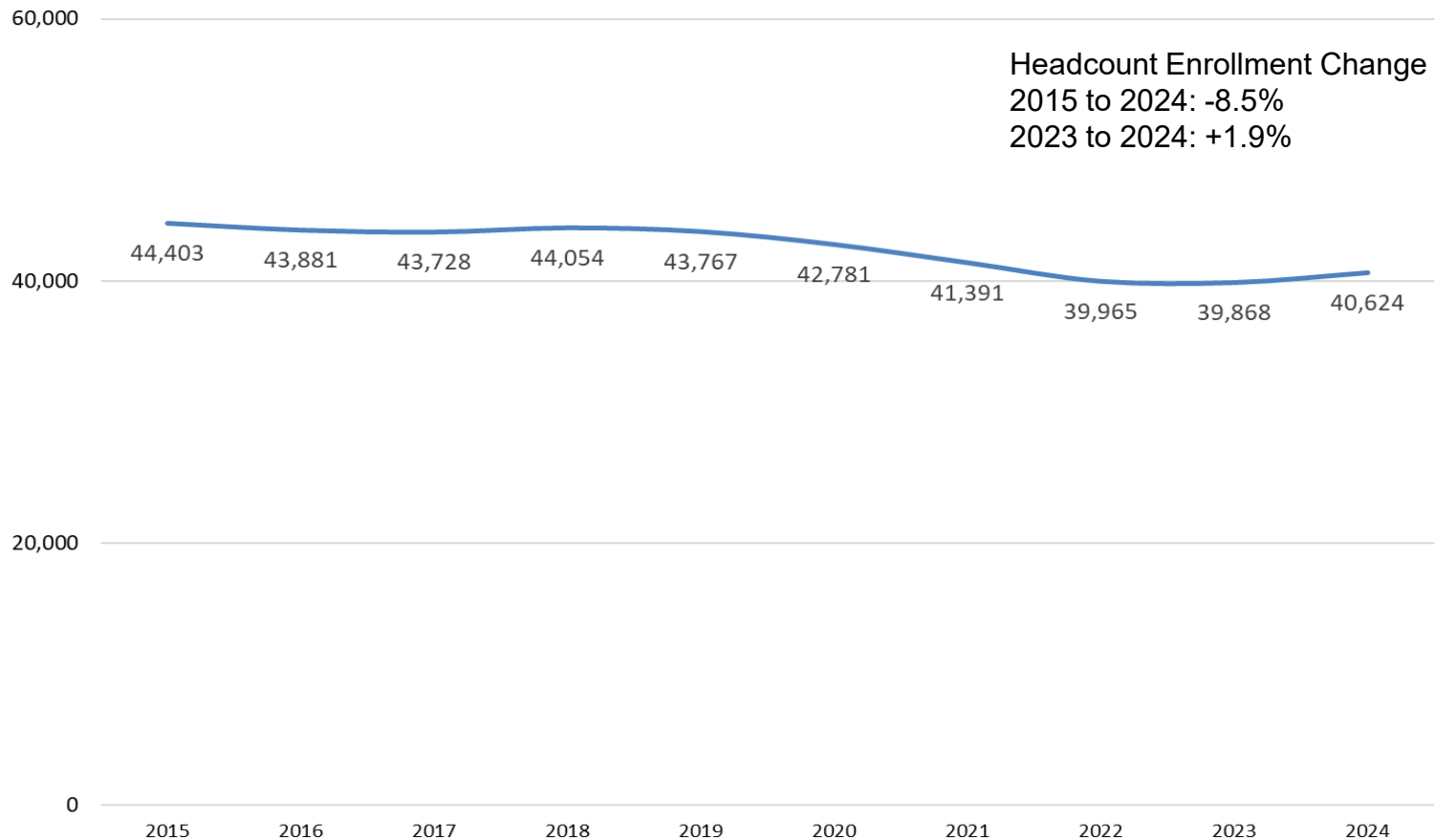

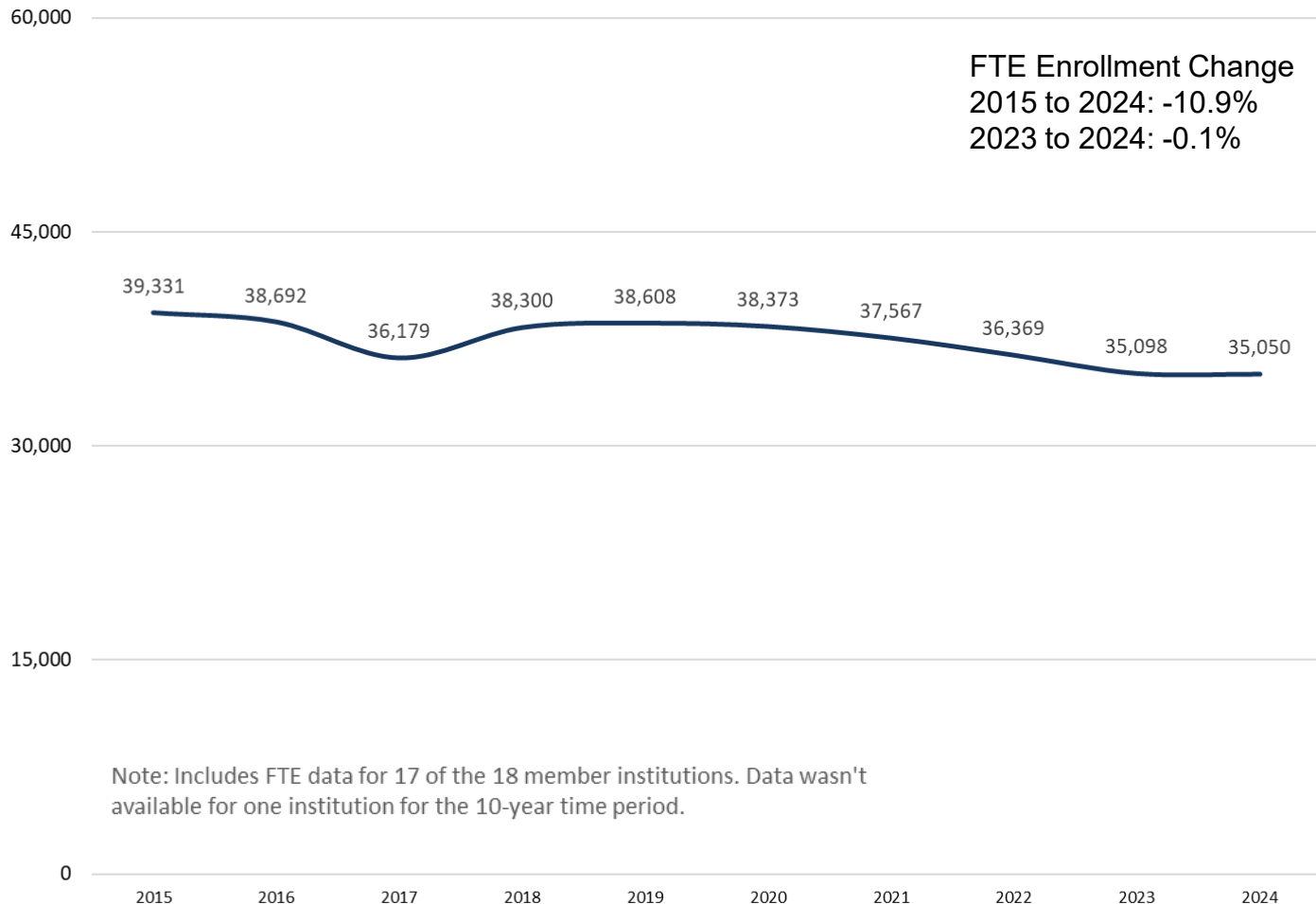
The Education We Offer

- All 18 member institutions offer bachelor's degrees
- 5 member institutions offer associate programs
- 8 member institutions offer non-traditional evening, weekend, and degree completion programs
- 15 member institutions offer graduate degrees
- 75% of headcount enrollment is undergraduate

The Students We Serve

- Students of color & Native American students: 33%
(international students not included)
- First-generation students: 20%
(neither parent earned a degree)
- Pell Grant recipients 25%
- Part-time students: 13%
- Adult learners: 8%
(25 or older)

And transfers account for 17% of new students annually
