The Mobile Health Initiative provides on-site preventative health services to improve wellness and health outcomes, promote disease screening and preventive care, and ensure access to healthcare for communities across Minnesota that exist in healthcare deserts.

ONE HEALTH CLINIC

Caring for companion animals and their families in a single setting

Pet owners are more likely to seek care for their pet than for themselves, particularly when resources are scarce. The One Health Clinic can be a bridge to humans getting the medical care they need while supporting the health of the companion animals that play such an important role in their owners' physical and mental wellbeing. In July 2024, the College of Veterinary Medicine partnered with the Phillips Neighborhood Clinic and the University's Medical School to pilot the first One Health Clinic. At the clinic, interdisciplinary teams of human medical professionals and veterinarians:

- Worked together to understand the needs of the individual and their pet
- Developed a unified healthcare plan that includes steps for both the owner and the animal's health
- Connected with community members that may not have sought out personal healthcare otherwise
