














# The Twin Cities is one of the most expensive non-coastal metros in America




### **Midwest Metros**

### Midwest New Home Price Point Distribution




Midwest Median New, Single-Family Home Price






### MSP Percent Growth, 2016-2023 (inflation adjusted)

- Floor design and construction






# **Energy + Environmental rules**

- High efficiency light bulbs
- Completing Environmental Assessment Worksheets for modest-size neighborhoods
- Having five or six wetland experts meet on-site to verify that wetland boundaries are correct








### **Local rules**

- Zoning: A lot of land reserved for detached single family homes
- Land use requirements:
  - Minimum lot size requirements
  - Parking requirements
- Density restrictions
  - Maximum height
- Aesthetic mandates
  - Requiring stone on the fronts of starter homes
- City fees can add tens of thousands to the cost of a new ER OF THE AMERICAN home

# **Proposed solutions**

- Rent control
- Subsidies
  - Downpayment assistance
  - Rent assistance
  - Grants to developers
  - TIF districts
  - Tax credits



### Housing

- Affordable housing is rare because it is effectively illegal to build
- 2) Subsidies will do nothing to solve these problems– costs remain high, they are just absorbed bythe taxpayer
- 3) Rent control only exacerbates the problem In the long-term
